

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MAGNETAWAN**

**BY-LAW No. 2004- 34**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT  
A LIVESTOCK VALUATOR, A LIVESTOCK ISOLATION POUND KEEPER  
AND A FENCE VIEWER**

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Act, R.S.O. 200J*, c.25, Sections 8, 9, 10 and 11 confer a broad authority on Municipalities

- (a) to enable them to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate; and
- (b) to enhance their ability to respond to Municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001*, c.25, Section 103 (l)(a) provides that the Council of any Municipality may by By-law, provide for seizure and impounding of animals being at large or trespassing;

**AND WHEREAS** this Municipality has passed By-law No. 2000-21, being a By-law to provide for the Licencing and Regulation of Dogs;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 4 of the *Livestock, Poultry and Honey Bee Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990*, as amended, requires every local Municipality to appoint one or more persons as valuers of livestock and poultry for the purpose of the *Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 2 of the *Line Fences Act, R.S.O. 1990*, as amended, requires Municipalities to appoint such number offence viewers as are required to carry out the provisions of the *Act*;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to appoint a Livestock Isolation Pound Keeper;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** as a By-law of The Corporation of the Municipality of Magnetawan as follows:

**1. Appointments**

1.1 That James Mahoney and Ralph Miller be appointed as Fence Viewers and be paid \$15.00 per hour when working in the appointed capacity plus forty-five (\$0.45) cents per kilometer for traveling expenses.

1.2 That Marie Miller be appointed as Isolation Pound Keeper and be paid \$15.00 per hour when working in the appointed capacity plus other statutory costs, plus forty-five (\$0.45) cents per kilometer for traveling expenses.

1.3 That Ralph Miller be appointed as Livestock Valuator and be paid \$ 15.00 per hour when working in the appointed capacity plus forty-five (\$0.45) cents per kilometer for traveling expenses.

**2. Term of Appointments**

2.1 The term of all appointments made within this By-law shall be at the pleasure of Council or until such time as this By-law is repealed.

**3. Repeal**

3.1 By-law No. 2002-16 shall be repealed on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2004.

**4.** This By-law shall come into force and take effect January 1, 2005.

**5. Passed in open Council as read a First, Second and Third time, this 24<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2004**
